Requirements:

Research

- Use the actual historical background as the context

Interpretation

- Establish the significance of the topic within the context of Beowulf
- Incorporate written explanations to support all of the above
- Include at least 4 quotations from the text

Visuals

- Include appropriate visual images to illustrate the topic

Mechanics

- No spelling, punctuation, or grammar errors

Presentation should be 10-15 minutes long.

Videos should not exceed a total of 5 minutes.

Bibliography (MLA style) with a minimum of 3 academic sources included at the end. (Include images, video, etc.)

Content	Meets all criteria of the previous level and is well organized using the features of Prezi. Demonstrates in depth research and application of critical thinking skills (analysis, synthesis, evaluation). Project shows notable insight or understanding of the topic.
